Message From the President

I want to thank Linda and Trina for all the hard work they have done on the newsletter. We really appreciate them for what they have done over the past year. This will be their last newsletter as we have a new company LPI taking over the newsletter in October.

Ashley has written several grant proposals which we have received. These include the following:

1. Miami County Foundation- new copier/printer and hand dryers for bathrooms (\$3510)
2. Duke Foundation- 3 industrial coolers and 1 freezer (\$12,000)
3. Meijer- \$250- for food for members and events
4. United Way \$22,000 annual dispersed \$5500 quarterly (unrestricted)
5. CBDG Fund \$55,000 (city approved – handicapped ramp off parking lot by the steps)
6. Troy Foundation- \$100 for decorations and photo booth for anniversary
7. Miami County commissioners- \$9545- unrestricted

We also have a monthly Dine to Donate at Skyline Chili which is bringing in about \$300 monthly. This is for the community to support the center; we do appreciate all members that eat at Skyline on the third Thursday of the month to support us.

We have had two community dinners which have netted us \$250. We have decided to do the dinners quarterly as they were being done by the same folks. We need more help!!!

September 13 | 3:00 pm - 6:00 pm

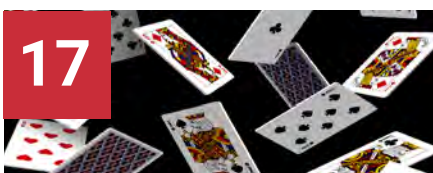
Postponed from July. Mayor Oda will be doing a ribbon cutting. The food truck The Rolling Oasis will be present. We will have cake and door prizes available as well.
